Governor Newsom has declared a State of Emergency to exist in California as a result of the threat of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The Governor issued Executive Order N-25-20 and N-29-20, which directs Californians to follow the public health directives including canceling large gatherings. After receiving recognition, please stand and state your name, as all meetings are being taped. Note that stating your name is a <u>voluntary</u> act and is not required.

Members of the public may submit written comments on any matter that is listed on the agenda or for general public comment.
